

- funding of a Faculty Enrichment Program whose aim is to promote establishing new Canadian studies courses at Italian universities;

- support for a scholarship and research program.

The Canadian party welcomes the intervention of Italian authorities in order to formally introduce courses on Canadian history and literature in English and French in Italian university curricula.

The Italian party expresses interest in the Canadian proposal, which it will submit to the competent academic authorities.

Article 14. Keeping in mind the provisions of Article V of the Cultural Agreement, the two parties will continue to exchange documentation and information in order to enable each to better understand the criteria and procedures followed by university institutions of the other country in determining admission standards for academic courses and programs as well as criteria for awarding degrees.

The Canadian party advises that the Canadian Academic Center, as well as the various Canadian Studies Centers in Italy and the Canadian Embassy can provide further information on this topic and to act as repositories of pertinent materials.

Article 15. The two parties, within the limits of the respective rules in effect, will facilitate the research activities in their territory of teaching staff, researchers and scholarship holders from the other country, especially with regard to access to museums, libraries, archeological sites and other cultural institutions.

IV. SCHOLARSHIPS

Article 16. The Italian party will award Canadian citizens eighty monthly scholarships per year for language, humanities, fine arts and science programs.

Article 17. The Canadian party will offer annually to Italian citizens 5 scholarships of a duration of one academic year each, granted within the framework of the Government of Canada Awards Program for post-graduate studies in the humanities, sciences and social sciences.
