

4. Agriculture and food processing, including storage, handling and distribution;
5. Construction, particularly the development of port, airport, road, rail and urban facilities;
6. Transportation and distribution services;
7. Aerospace, particularly regional aircraft;
8. Manufacturing, especially transportation equipment;
9. Environmental protection;
10. Human resource development;
11. Institution building, particularly in the economic policy, environmental and legal fields;
12. Professional business services;
13. Financial services; and
14. Other sectors as agreed between the Parties.

ARTICLE V

Institutions

1. Implementation of this Agreement shall require close coordination and consultation between the two governments. Consequently, the Parties agree to establish a Joint Economic Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") to accomplish the objectives of the Agreement and to discuss any matter relating to this Agreement;
2. The Commission shall be composed of representatives of both Parties at the level of Ministers or senior officials, which officials shall be designated by the Vietnamese Government and the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade of Canada. The Commission shall meet at regular intervals, with meetings alternating between Canada and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam;
3. The Commission shall establish such committees or working groups as may be necessary. The composition of such working groups shall be decided by both Parties.
