<u>Mr. Rogers</u> was born in Toronto on November 23, 1919, and is a graduate of the University of Toronto. After joining the Canadian Army in 1942, he served in Newfoundland, in the United Kingdom and in northwestern Europe. Mr. Rogers became a member of the Department of External Affairs in 1946, serving with Canadian diplomatic missions in Washington and Tokyo. <u>In 1958</u> he A was appointed Counsellor in London, and in 1960, Counsellor with the Canadian Delegation to the North Atlantic Council. Since July 1963, Mr. Rogers has been Head of the Far Eastern Division of the Department of External Affairs.
