PRAYERS.

The House resumed consideration in Committee of the Whole of a certain proposed resolution to amend the Disabled Persons Act.

(In the Committee)

The following resolution was adopted:

Resolved,—That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Disabled Persons Act to increase to sixty-five dollars per month the maximum amount of allowance in respect of which payments may be made to the provinces under the provisions of that Act, and to increase the total amount of allowable income, inclusive of allowance, by one hundred and eighty dollars a year in the case of an unmarried person and three hundred and sixty dollars a year in the case of a married person.

Resolution to be reported.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in.

Mr. Monteith (Perth), seconded by Mr. Churchill, by leave of the House, presented Bill C-62, An Act to amend the Disabled Persons Act, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading later this day.
