

Government Orders

That this House commends the exemplary conduct of the men and women of the Canadian Forces at Oka and Chateaugay.

That, in the opinion of this House, the laws of Canada must apply on all Canadian territory, including Kahnawake, and that all persons currently at the Kanesatake Treatment Centre should lay down their arms and submit to the processes of Canada's judicial system, thereby encouraging the creation of a constructive climate for discussions between governments and the Mohawk people on land claims and other issues; and

That upon adoption of this motion, the said motion shall be deemed referred to the Standing Committee on Justice and Solicitor General.

And the amendment of Ms. Blondin:

That the motion be amended by deleting all the words after the word "Châteaugay" and replacing them with the following:

"and that this House condemns the complete failure of the government to address and offer solutions to the problems that led to the Armed Forces being deployed; and

That upon adoption of this motion, the said motion be deemed referred to the Standing Committee on Aboriginal Affairs.

And the subamendment of Ms. McLaughlin:

That the motion be amended by deleting the words "this House condemns the complete failure of the government" and replacing them with:

"this House condemns the complete failure of the current and past governments".
