

PREFACE.

Even since the issue, last year, of my book:—
“*L'Angleterre, Le Canada et la Grande Guerre*”—
“*England, Canada and the Great War*”—a second
edition of which I had to publish, a few weeks
later, to meet the pressing demand of numerous
readers—I have been repeatedly asked by influen-
tial citizens to publish an English edition of my
work.

A delegate from Quebec to the National Unity
—or Win-the-War—Convention, in Montreal, I
had the pleasure of meeting a great many of the
delegates from Toronto and all over the Dominion.
Many of them insisted upon the publication of an
English edition.

Having written that book for the express and
patriotic purpose of proving the justice of the
cause of the Allies in the Great War, and refuting
Mr. Bourassa's false and dangerous theories, I
realized that the citizens of Quebec, Montreal,
Ottawa and Toronto, who strongly advised an
English edition to be circulated in all the Prov-
inces, appreciated the good it could make.
