9. Any offender who escapes from any such house of refuge Recapture of before her sentence therein has expired, may be again arrested prisoner. without any warrant by any sheriff, sheriff's bailiff or constable of the county, city, town or village in which she may be found 5 and conveyed to the house of refuge for females from which she escaped, or to the county gaol of the county from which she was first removed, and she shall there be confined in such house of refuge or gaol for the balance of the period of her sentence which remained unexpired at the time of her escape.

10 10. Whenever the time of the sentence of any prisoner Prisoners not removed to a house of refuge expires on a Sunday she shall be to be discharged on the previous Saturday unless she desires to Sunday. remain until the following Monday.

15 refuge for females at the termination of her sentence if then to be discharged if labouring under any contagious or infectious disease or under labouring under any acute or dangerous illness, but she shall be permitted to disease. remain in the house of refuge until she recovers from the disease or illness, and any prisoner remaining from any such cause 20 in the house of refuge shall be under the same discipline or control as if her sentence were still unexpired.

12. No prisoner shall be committed to any house of refuge Persons not without the consent of the superintendent, superior or other mitted without consent of superintendent.
