BILL E2.

An Act to incorporate The Ottawa and Lake
McGregor Railway Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it ^{Preamble.}
be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient
to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His
