REGULATIONS.

SECTION XIX.

THE PROPERTY OF THE INSTITUTE.

I. The whole of the property and effects of the Institute, of what kind soever, shall be vested in the Council of the Institute, and subject to its control.

2. Every paper, map, plan, or drawing, which may be presented to the Institute, shall be considered the property thereof, unless there shall have been some previous arrangement to the contrary; and the Council may publish the same in connection with their transactions or, with the consent of the author, in any other form. No communication made to the Institute shall be published by any other person but the author, without the previous consent of the Council.

3. Every paper presented to the Institute for publication shall be referred to an Editing Committee appointed by the Council. Notices or abstracts of all papers not published in full shall be prepared by the Secretary and inserted in the Transactions.

4. No papers, plans, maps, or other property belonging to the Institute, shall be taken out of the rooms thereof, without the consent of the Council; but every member shall have a right to inspect the same at such hours as the Council may appoint.
