- 2. The following Motions shall be in order at any time:
 - (a.) To adjourn the meeting.
 - (b.) To postpone the discussion.
 - (c.) To refer to the General Committee.
- 3. The following time shall be allowed in the Order of Business:
 - (a.) Twenty minutes to the Essayist.
 - (b.) Fifteen minutes to each Speaker.
- (c.) Ten minutes to the Opener for his reply at the close of the debate.
- 4. Every Motion, and Notice of Motion, before being read to the Society shall be put in writing by the mover.
- 5. Each Member, during the last fortnight of each term, shall hand to the Secretary four questions for debate, from which the General Committee shall select such as may be approved.
- 6. The Secretary shall prepare a list of the Essayists and Debaters for each meeting during the year, and place the same in the Reading Room.
