

XXVI. It is ordered that all posts placed in any of the streets in Quebec which are a nuisance to the public be immediately removed on pain of twenty shillings.

REGULATIONS for the public Ferries in the District of QUEBEC.

Whereas it is necessary and expedient to fix the rates that shall be paid for the passage over the following Ferries, It is ordered that the following rates be paid, and that the different Ferry-men govern themselves thereby: and any Ferryman asking or demanding more than the rates here fixed shall pay a fine of ten shillings.
