BY-LAW NO. 874.

By-Law to Re-Appoint Committee re Nation
River Drainage.

Whereas a special session of this Council
held at the Court House in the Town of Corn-
wall, on the first day of August, A.D., 1884, a
By-Law was passed appointing a Committee
to supervise the drainage of the Nation River.

And whereas it has become necessary to re-
appoint the said Committee and provide va-
cancies occasioned by certain members of
this Council ceasing to be members.

It is therefore enacted a By-Law of the Cor-
poration of the United Counties of Stormont
Dundas and Glengarry, that A. Harkness,
Reeve, Matilda; Mr. Dickey, Reeve, Wil-
liamsburgh; Mr. Fulton, Deputy-Reeve, Win-

chester; Mr. Kennedy, Reeve, Mountain, and
Mr. Kerr, Reeve, Osnabruk; be the Com-
mittee as provided for in the original By-Law,
and that the said Committee be authorized to
take such action as may be necessary to carry
out the intention of the said By-Law.

BY-LAW NO. 875.

By-Law Authorizing the Borrowing of Money
to meet Current Expenditure of the River
Beaudette Drainage Improvements.

Whereas it will be necessary to borrow a
certain sum to meet the expenditure upon the
River Beaudette Drainage Improvements be-
tween this time and the sale of the deben-
tures.

Be it therefore enacted a By-Law of the Cor-
poration of the United Counties of Stormont,
Dundas and Glengarry, that the Warden and
Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized
to borrow from some chartered Bank of the
Dominion, for the purpose above set forth,
such sum or sums of money as may be neces-
sary in the opinion of the River Beaudette
Drainage Committee, provided said sum or
sums of money shall not exceed One Thousand
Dollars, and shall execute for said sum or
sums of money a note or notes under the seal
of the Corporation, payable at such date or
dates as may be agreed upon within the cur-
rent year, and also to renew all notes.
