

Leeds and Grenville Spent \$29,395 on Improvements. BROCKVILLE, Jan. 27.—(Special).—At this afternoon's meeting of the county council the good roads commission presented a report covering the past year's operations. Roads and bridges rebuilt, entailed an outlay of \$29,395. The commissioners suggested that the council petition the minister of public works for Ontario for \$9708, being one-third of the total expenditure which is due the counties under the highway improvement act.
