NORWAY, July 15.—(Special.)—Practically without a moment's warning and while six men were working at the foundations a large portion of the northeast corner of the Norway Public Schoolhouse fell outward about 2 o'clock this afternoon, with a deafening crash. By prompt action the men escaped with their lives, the covered with dust from the debris.

The board of education some time ago awarded the contracts for the addition of eight rooms to the Norway schools, making extensions on the east and west of four rooms each. Under the northern wall it was proposed to install a large boiler for heating purposes, and it was while excavating the basement the accident occurred.
