Camphor Balls for the nands.

Cut small an ounce of spermaceti, an ounce of camphor, and one of white wax; put them into a couple of ounces of almond oil, and melt with a gentle degree of heat over a fire. Pour the mixture into gallipots, and rub it on ender the wind a gentle degree of heat over a fire.
