Your committee is of the opinion also that a better and closer collection of stumpage from crown lands could be made with much advantage to the provincial revenues; also that there could be an improved system for the collection of licenses from motor vehicles which could be greatly assisted by the road superiors throughout the province reporting any automobile owners who infringed upon the regulations.

considerable increase of revenue from these sources as well as from an increase of royalties on coal and iron. A word for Dr. J. V. Anglin. Your committee was much pleased with the business-like statement and satisfactory accounts of the superintendent of the provincial hospital for nervous diseases. The expenditures in connection with the Jordan Memorial Sanitarium appeared to be very large and your committee recommends that in future, if practicable, tenders for supplies for both the provincial hospital and the Jordan Memorial Sanitarium should be called for on bloc.
