



Mrs. Edward Hatfield, of The Forks, Quinan, Yarmouth County, N. S., and her three young children were drowned yesterday when a rowboat which they were in upset and threw them into the Tusket River. Mrs. Hatfield had been answering the call of two women to ferry them across the river when the children moved in the boat. She leaned over to touch them and the craft capsized. One of the women ran for assistance and the other has been missing ever since. She was traced for some distance into the woods but could not be found up to a late hour last night. The bodies of Mrs. Hatfield, one boy and one girl were recovered. The one missing is that of the other boy. At an inquest yesterday afternoon a verdict of accidental drowning was brought in.
