RECORD DATES BACK TO EIGHTIES

Bobby Veach's Performance Last Year When He Secured Six Hits in One Game Was Equalled by "Old Timers."

New York, March 10.—While only one major league player, Robert Veach of Detroit, made six hits to six times at bat in one game last season, the list of these individuals has been increased by three, according to Editor John B. Foster's baseball guide.

These men, batting six times in games in 1885, each made six hits, the Brooklynite contenting himself with getting singles. Orr did better. In the game with the famous St. Louis Browns, played at the Polo Grounds, June 12, 1885, Orr made two singles, two doubles, one triple and one home run against the pitching of Bob Carruthers. Orr seemed to gauge the delivery of Carruthers and to perfection every time he struck the ball it went from his bat like a shot from a cannon. The Mets won, 7 to 4.

BETTER SINCE REFERENDUM IN MANITOBA

Winnipeg, Man., March 9.—(Canadian Press Limited)—Since the referendum on Feb. 1 there has been a noticeable decrease in the number of infractions of the Manitoba Temperance Act and conditions in general are much better, according to N. L. MacLean, administrator of the act.

"Whether this indicates a permanent improvement or not is hard to say at present," he said. "We look to the Quebec liquor act for a great deal of help. Montreal was the source of a big percentage of our illicit traffic and with storehouses there under government control we do not expect much from that quarter."

PLATINUM PRODUCTION IN BRITISH COLUMBIA.

Victoria, B. C., March 9.—(Canadian Press Limited)—That production of platinum in British Columbia is on the point of becoming an important industry is the opinion of S. J. Marsh, a prominent mining man, who says that investigations which he has conducted for many years have disclosed that one of the principle platinum deposits in the world is in the Fraser river and three of its tributaries—the Oycene, the Wil-low and the Cottonwood rivers. A plant is being built and it is expected that reduction will be begun this spring, said Mr. Marsh.

He believes that for 250 miles on the Fraser and 150 miles on tributary streams 75 per cent of the black sand to the extent of from eight to forty deposits can be dredged and concentrates pounds a cubic yard of dirt obtained.
