## FAMOUS RINGS IN HISTORY

President Wilson's Shakespeare's and Wilhelm's All Bear Initials of Owners

(N. Y. Times.)  
The signet ring of President Wilson used to affix his name to the Peace Treaty at Versailles became historic on that famous document. The origin of that ring upon which the president's name is engraved in Pitman shorthand, was described at the time in numerous cable dispatches sent out from Paris by correspondents at the Peace Conference.  
In comparing President Wilson's ring with those of other famous men, it is interesting to note that he, William Shakespeare, and the former Kaiser of Germany were among the few who had their names or their initials upon their signet rings.  
In his book on "Rings," Dr. George P. Kunz of Tiffany & Co. describes many of the most famous rings of history, and he has included among them the ring used by Mr. Wilson, of which he says:  
"A novel idea finds expression in the ring of President Wilson, on which he has engraved his name in stenographic symbols. This is in thorough agreement with his aim to utilize business methods in the administration of national affairs, to do away with routine and take the most direct route to the solution of national problems."  
When he wrote to ex-President William Howard Taft for a description of his signet ring Dr. Kunz received a letter from Mr. Taft in which he said: "I never wear a finger ring and never have done so. For that reason I cannot comply with your request." The president's failure to possess such an ornament is regarded by Dr. Kunz as an example of his many democratic characteristics.  
Aerxes, the Persian sovereign, is said to have had a signet upon which was engraved the figure of a nude woman with disheveled hair, representing Astarte, the Persian goddess of fertilization. From literary sources, says Dr. Kunz, it has been possible to ascertain

The signet ring of Charles V. of France was set with an Oriental ruby, on which was engraved the bearded head of a king. This seal was used by King Charles to seal the letters written by his own hand. Much has been written about the ring, for rather the engraved seal of Michael Angelo, the dimensions are given as 15 mm. by 11 mm. The shield is that of Scotland, surrounded by a design emblemizing twelve human figures. Two girls, a boy, a goat, and a tree. Two of the figures appear to have been copied from a detail of Michael Angelo's "The Fall of Man," a woman helping another woman to place a basket of grapes upon her head.

**Shakespeare's Ring Found.**  
"The signet ring of Mary Stuart is one of the chief treasures in the ring collection of the British Museum. It was found for her use after her betrothal to the French Dauphin, later, for a few months, King of France as Francis II. The shield is that of Scotland, surrounded by the collar of the thistle, with the badge, and supported by two unicorns charged and ducally gorged.  
"A signet ring, believed by many to be that of the immortal Shakespeare, was found on March 16, 1910. The initial letters are bound together with a design composed of an ornamental hand with tassels, so arranged as to outline a heart. A queer coincidence, if the report be true, is that a certain William Shakespeare, chiselled steel figures of a lion and a unicorn. The gold bezel has a steel facing constituting the seal.  
"Dieu et mon Droit," inscribed in letters of steel.  
"The signet ring used by Kaiser William II. is set with a reddish-white opal, on which has been engraved and surrounded by a crown and the letters W. H. I. R. Wilhelm der Zweite, Emperor of Germany. It is a richly ornamented shield, the top of which is surmounted by the Kaiser's grandfathers, William I. and was adapted to the former Kaiser's use.

Interest in signet rings has been greatly revived since 1900, according to Dr. Kunz, who explains that many of the designs are cut in gold or platinum, of which the entire ring is made, and are jeweled with rubies, sapphires, emeralds, or diamonds, and for these prices as high as \$1,000 to \$10,000 are paid.

the designs engraved upon the rings of many of the Roman Emperors preceding the Christian era, although few of these rings have been preserved. The ring of Scipio Africanus, conqueror of Hannibal, bore the portrait of his father, and his son followed his example. Sulla, on the first signet he had designed, endeavored to perpetuate the memory of his victory over Jugurtha, and later he selected one with a portrait of Alexander the Great.

**Cesar's Signet an Armed Venus.**  
"The two rivals, Pompey and Caesar, chose widely divergent symbols," says Dr. Kunz. "The former wore a signet engraved with a lion, bearing a sword, while on Caesar's ring was cut an armed Venus, the Venus Victoria, from whom the Jews, claimed descent, and for whose statue Caesar is said to have brought pearls from Britain to be set in the statue's breastplate. The first choice made by Augustus was a sphinx, in symbolical allusion to his lactation by the she-bear of the Tiber. The second choice was a figure of Apollo, cut by the hand of the sculptor, which he undoubtedly identified himself with the sun god and leader of the muses, who took the vengeance upon his rival by having their names engraved around the setting. In this way, Caracalla utilized an antique gem showing a female bust, with hair tied in a knot, while Charlemagne's choice was a gem engraved with the head of Marcus Aurelius. At a later time he substituted for this one bearing the head of the Alexandrian god, Serapis.  
"Of the seal of the Prophet Mohammed, we are told by Ibn Kaldoun that when he was about to send a letter to the Emperor Heraclius his attention was called to the fact that no letter would be received by a foreign potentate unless it bore the impression of the prophet's seal. Mohammed, therefore, had
