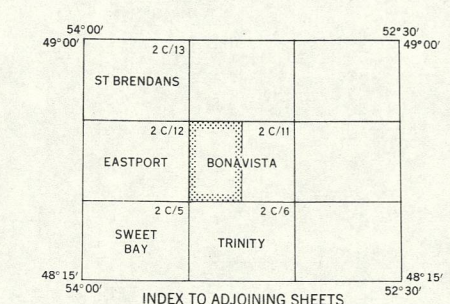
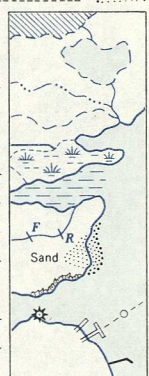

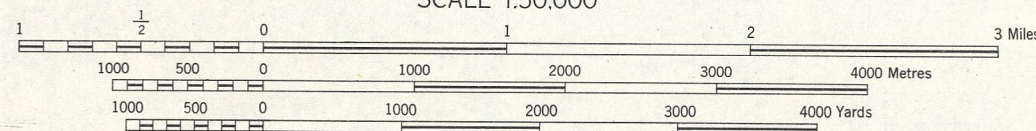
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 30°20' WEST,
