FIRST CHURCH ORGAN USED A HUNDRED YEARS AGO

In Scotland — It Was Built by James Watt, the Famous Inventor — A Long Struggle Before Its Adoption, and Many Disputes Afterwards.

GLASGOW, Sept. 14.—The twenty-third of August, a little over one hundred years ago, was a Sunday, and on it in one of the city churches of Glasgow, occurred a notable event. For the first time in the history of any Presbyterian church in the country an organ was used in public worship. An innovation so daring had not long to wait for a stirring sequel. The two weeks at once in a ferment. But it was not the church courts which took action; it was an alert municipality. The lord provost instantly brought the matter before the town council, and the city fathers in their capacity as heritors rose in wrath and with unflinching voice called upon the ecclesiastical jurisdiction to exercise its authority, and for the sake of the peace of the community put an end to the evil thing.

The church which ventured on this bold step was St. Andrew's parish church. This steeple of all the city fancies stood then, as it stands still, in the midst of its own square. A century ago it was also in the centre of fashion and culture, and its congregation was largely drawn from the professional classes and the wealthy. The organ was a man of wide travel and scholarly accomplishments, and of such high reputation in the church as to have been invited to the seat of the general assembly. While he was undoubtedly the willing leader in the introduction of instrumental music without leave asked of any civil or ecclesiastical authority, he was not the prime mover in the matter. He advised before the Presbytery that far more than thirty years a wish had been cherished by St. Andrew's church to have an organ erected and employed in public worship, and it was only after repeated proposals had been made to him by the leaders of the congregation that he gave his consent with the full approval of his mind. At the same time nothing but his unflinching faith and noble influence can explain the fact that, at a time when public opinion was quite unprepared to sanction so pronounced a departure from ancient usage, there was entire unanimity among his people; for never through all the protracted and bitter public controversy which ensued was there the slightest difference of opinion indicated among the members of this advanced congregation.
