Copy of a DESPATCH from Governor *Reid* to Earl *Grey*.

My Lord,

Government House, Barbados, 23 February 1847.

REFERRING to your Lordship's Circular Despatch of the 22d of August 1846, requiring information relative to Lighthouses in the colonies, I have now the honour to transmit copies of despatches from the different Lieutenant-governors of the Windward Islands on the subject.

St. Lucia and Tobago are the only two islands in this government on which there are Lighthouses.
