II. And be it further enacted, That an Ast made in the Forty-ninth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for allowing, until the Twenty-sifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and ten, the Importation of certain Fish from Parts of the Coast of His Majesty's North American Colonies, and for granting a Bounty thereon, shall from and after the taid Twenty-sifth Day of March be revived, and the same is hereby revived, and further continued until the Twenty-sifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and eleven.
