It was not my intention to state that the Indian reserve at Rocky Point does not adjoin the Charlottetown summe Resorts. I simply wi wished to make plain that only cattle running at large could get into the land owned by the company of which we Cotton is manager. I enclose a rough sketch of the reserve as I understand it. On the North side there is no fence on the spit side the reserve runs to the water front. On the South side there was a wire fence placed between the reserve and the Charlottetown Summer Resorts with a gate for persons walking but not for a carriageOn the west side there is a road at least a temporary one and there was a fence put up there but as state d the Indians cut the posts for firewood and the fence was down. The wire is still there . The fence on the south side is almost all there and could be repaired but would not be of any use as a protection to the property of the Sunmer resorts without one on the west side where the posts have been cut. I am not sure if the same company has both the Holland Cove and the Charlottetown Summer resorts property but it is not leased but is held by them by purchase I have not a copy of the deed of the property which the Department purchased for the reserve or the agreement which was made about the style of fence to be kept up. In any case it cannot be of any practical use to have the fence placed there now as the season is over and no persons will occupy the bungalows till next season. Juliam Donaly Luclian Supt.
