In 1878 the Crown Lands Departing out a Reserve at "la Inque" subseques the Subject was frequently mentioned, and in the spring of 1881 I received instruction for the work; I thereufon asked to an advance of \$300 which I received. very shortly afterwards I received from Mr Deville of the Dep! ofthe Interes an offer of a Lurvey in the North Welg which I declined with thanks, State that I was engaged to go up the S. Manie
