Sir,

I beg to inform you that Mr. Frederick C. Scaman, of Strathcona, the owner by assignment, of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 6, -52-24-W. 4th M., Papaschase Reserve Sale 36, has applied for an extension of time for payment of the arrears against this property. In reply he has been informed that as there were on the 1st February last some nine instalments of \$68.00 each payable with interest, three of which, however, had been paid between the date of sale and the 18th February 1898, leaving the arrears from 1st February last, six instalments or \$408.00, Principal, together with interest thereon.

Mr. Scaman was informed further that in view of the statements made in his letter, the Department would extend the time until after harvest of the present year, when, if a substantial payment should then have been made a reasonable time would be allowed him for payment of the remainder.
