As to the point of land to which you refer, I beg to say that, from the description given the same cannot be identified, but I am inclosing you a plan of the Bruce Peninsula, and the islands in front thereof, and if you will be good enough to give a description of the land to which you refer from this plan, the matter will be given due consideration.
