Sir,-

With reference to your communication of the 5th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of the resolution passed by the St. Regis Council to the effect that in future when any member of the Band has business which he or she desires to be adjusted, the matter should be brought before the Council of the Band for decision, or for report thereon to the Department, (should such action be deemed advisable. The Department agrees with the Council that it is unwise for members of the Council to make frequent visits to the Department thereby incurring unnecessary expense. As a rule the matter in regard to which they desire action taken could be dealt with by the Council. The Indians generally should be advised to the above effect.
