The remaining provisions of the typewritten draft correspond to provisions of the draft bills previously submitted and are included verbatim in the attached print, except that Section 8 of the typewritten draft regarding Information has been omitted as it is understood that this Section was struck out of the third print draft when this was before Council. Possibly that provision should be restored though in view of the restoration to the bill of the authority to make a national registration and survey. On the other hand, it may be felt that it is preferable to make provisions of this kind by Order in Council under the War Measures Act or the Mobilization Act.

Attention is called to the wording of Section 11 of the attached print corresponding to Section 12 of the typewritten draft. When the Mobilization Act was before Farliament, an amendment was proposed by the Leader of the Opposition to provide for the sending of orders to Members of Farliament, etc. It may be desired to anticipate a similar proposal for a similar amendment to the present bill. In this event, the wording of Section 5 of the Mobilization Act should be substituted for Section 11 in the attached print.
