I, K21112 L/Bdr. Christieson W.L. on the night of
December 15th, 1942 was i/c 108 Bty Piquet.
At 2000 hrs. Gnr. Keeshig was relieved by me of his post and I
told him to report to the guard room. I performed my other duties
and at approximately 2015 hrs. I returned to the guard room to
find Gnr. Keeshig missing. I looked through the quarters and
didn't see him. I reported the matter and didn't see Gnr. Keeshig
again till 2100 hrs. when he reported to the guard room.

Will state:-

I was 108 Bty Orderly Officer on Dec 15th, 1942.
At approximately 2030 hrs. K21112 L/Bdr. Christieson W.L.
reported to me that four members of his piquet, including
Gnr. Keeshig were A.W.L. I went to the guard room and did
not see Gnr. Keeshig. I then went through Holyrood School
where the 108 Bty is quartered but did not see Gnr. Keeshig.
At approximately 2100 hrs. L/Bdr. Christieson came to the
Orderly Room and reported that Gnr. Keeshig had returned to
the guard room. I went to the guard room and saw Gnr. Keeshig
and told him to consider himself under Close arrest and
ordered L/Bdr. Christieson to keep Gnr. Keeshig under Close
Arrest. Gnr. Keeshig was undergoing Field Punishment at the
time. On 1 Dec 42 he was awarded 21 days Field Punishment by
the C.O.
