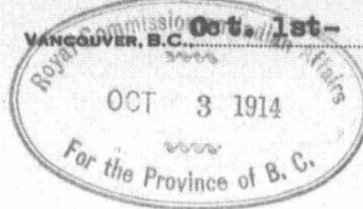

Dear Mr. Bergeron,-

I have just received your letter of September
29th.

In reply, I beg to inform you that if you will refer to copy of my letter to the Indian Commission, which I sent you on May 16th last, you will see that unorganized districts, as far as the game laws are concerned, are declared by Order-in-Council, and they consist of the Provincial Electoral Districts of Comox, Alberni, Skeena, Atlin, Lillooet and Cariboo,-- the rest of the Province is organized. There is, therefore, no reason why your Commission should not know these facts.

Copy of this letter was also sent to Inspectors of Indian Agencies at Victoria, Vernon and Vancouver, and to the Indian Agents at Ft. Steele; Vernon; Kamloops; New Westminster; Duncans and Lytton.
