N. B.—To conjugate any verb in compound tenses, use *avoir* or *être* in all their simple tenses, together with the past participle of another verb.

<i>J'ai eu</i>	(=I have had)	<i>J'avais été</i>	(=I had been).
<i>J'eus ouvert</i>	(=I had open.)	<i>J'serai loué</i>	(=I shall be praised).
