Faith is impregnable when it is fortified by experience. To one who has passed through the Gospels into fellowship with the Living Saviour of whom they testify, it matters nothing though criticism denies their historicity. He believes in them because he believes in Jesus; and he believes in Jesus because he knows Him.
