

they are daily secured by each boat engaged in fishing.

The fish at this season are of very superior quality—less than two hundred of them fill a barrel, which sells for four pounds.

Some few of our people have late years given their attention to fishing. Markers and boats have been repaired. During the present season, we believe there are instances of young men having cleared upwards of two hundred pounds.

It must be matter of surprise to strangers, as it is to us, that the fisheries of this Island, so valuable and productive, should have remained so long neglected.

At the present day, although the harbour of Charlottetown teems with haddock, we believe not a fresh fish to be had in the market.

The proceedings before the Royal Commissioners were appointed to settle the vexed question, which for years has been the subject of fruitless legislation in Prince Edward Island.
