Oliver Wendell Holmes, physician, philosopher, and worst of ali, POET, took up the idea and forced it upon the attention of the medical profession in America. The profession, true to form, ridiculed Holmes and the theory that childbed fever was contagious. But Holmes was a philosopher and did not go insane. Poets seldom do-thy're born that
