The situation in the molasses market locally is normal. Supplies are not exceptionally heavy. The demand has fallen off considerably and very few sales have been made. Whole salers reduced the price to \$1.50 per gallon yesterday and retailers are asking \$2 per gallon. The wholesalers say that in reducing the price, they have cut their margin of profit so that it actually does not exist and they are losing by the transportation. —St. John Telegraph.
