A Bomb Exploded in His Palace Rome.

Bome. Rome, March 17.—This morning a bomb exploded on the Ancini Mattai Palace, the residence of U.S. Minister Potter. The ex-plosion did but slight damage. The United States Minister called at the Foreign Office this afternoon and told Signor Brin, Minister of Foreign Affairs, he was convinced that the explosion was not intend-ed to injure him or affront the United States Government. He expressed his regret that such an embarrassing incident had occurred and assured Signor Brin of the sympathy of the United States Government and its will-inguess to let the affair pass unnoticed. Signor Brin thanked him for his visit and two hours later returned the call to inform him that the Italian Government felt the deepest regret on account of the inconveni-ence caused to him and his family by the explosion.




