The Mills are located at Scotstown, P.Q.; the Limits, about 8 1/2 square miles, in the Townships of Chesham, Emberton, Ditton and Hampden.

SAW MILL.

One short side and one long side circular, one Wicks 44-in sectional gang with separate engine for running same, one double edger, live rolls, lath machinery, filing room, electric light plant, and all that goes to make up a modern, economical saw mill; steam power plant exceptionally good

CLAPBOARD, PULPWOOD, AND PLANING MILL.

Full set of clapboard machinery, also pulpwood with roasting machines a d conveyors direct from machines into cars, two Woods planing and matching machines; ample steam power plant.

LIMITS.

Estimated to contain an area of about 8 1/2 sq. miles. According to the report of Augustus M. Carter of Bethel, Me., a well and favorably known estimator, there was on the Limits 125 million feet Spruce saw-logs and 50,000 cords of pulpwood, and tributary thereto, belonging to settlers, rising 33 million feet of spruce saw-logs and 25,000 cords of pulpwood, in addition to what would come by purchase from private lands in Ditton and Hampden townships. (Since report was made, there has been taken off from the Limits about 25 million feet saw-logs and 9,000 cords of pulpwood.) Mr Carter's responsibility is well known to the Berlin Mills Co., of Portland, Me. His estimate was verified by C. L. Crawford, of Boston, which is attached to the Carter report
