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MINUTES OF THE SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE
ONTARIO COLLEGE OF PHARMACY.

The minutes of the meeting held February 2nd were read, and on motion were adopted.

Business arising out of the minutes were then disposed of; the first item being the selection of a motto for the Arms of the College. After some discussion, it was moved by Mr. Gregory, seconded by Mr. Jordan, that the mottoes presented for insertion in the diploma, be handed to the Committee appointed for that purpose, and that they be requested to make a report of those they think most suitable at the next meeting of Council.
