Besides these there are: One BRUNSWICK Exhibition (\$50); Three STEVENSON Science Scholarships (\$50); One McCRAWLEY Hebrew Prize (\$36); One COGSWELL Scholarship (\$20), open for Candidates for Holy Orders; One McCRAWLEY Testimonial Scholarship (\$36); One AKINS Historical Prize (\$30); One ALMON WELSPOR Testimonial (\$24); One HALBURTON Prize (\$20); One COGSWELL Cricket prize. The necessary expenses of Board, Rooms, &c., average \$15 per annum. Nominated students do not pay tuition fees. These nominations are in number, are open to all Matriculated Students, and are worth about \$90 for the three years course. 
