

75. The two countries will exchange informational and bibliographic material, as well as periodicals, on the following subjects: social work and social-work methodology; literature; the training and on-going development of foreign-service officials; and international affairs.

76. The two Parties will from time to time exchange books and other publications on the history of the two countries' international relations, as well as any items published by their respective foreign ministries.

VII. PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS

77. The two Parties will promote the development of ties between sports organisations having similar fields of endeavour, with a view to exchanges of programmes, documentation, and the results of research work, as well as specialists, athletes, and materials pertaining to other aspects of sports.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

VIII. OTHER MATTERS

78. The Parties will from time to time review and evaluate the progress being made in carrying out this Programme, in each country's capital city, with the two countries' respective embassies and any concerned organisations taking part.
