COMPANY	ACTIVITY
Alcan Siam Limited	Producer of aluminum sheet and foil; acquired from Reynolds in 1983. The company is owned 85 per cent by Alcan and 15 per cent by local investors.
Aqua Marine	Agency agreement with Bangkok Motorworks.
Art Bronzes International Ltd.	Joint venture to produce artistic bronze castings of works by Canadian artists in limited editions to be marketed in North America and Europe.
Bata Shoe Company of Thailand Ltd.	Longest standing Canadian investment in Thailand; company first established over 50 years ago. Recently expanded production facilities in Thailand which uses Canadian-made shoe-making equipment.
Champion Road Machinery Ltd.	Licensing agreement to Champthai Company Ltd. assembly of road graders for the domestic market.
Ganong Limited	Joint venture between Ganong Brothers Limited of St. Stephen, New Brunswick, and Rubia Industries (a subsidiary of Berli Jucker) to manufacture and export top quality confectionery products to North America.
Imperial Flavours Inc.	Three joint venture agreements with Prachaub Fruit Company, Tipco and Samroyed.
Laemthong Protein Foods Co. Ltd.	Joint venture between Protein Foods Ltd. and Laemthong through which technology has been transferred for chicken deboning and production of processed chicken products.
