

FURTHER PERIOD. CONSULTATIONS TO THIS END HAVE BEEN HELD WITH THE NORWEGIAN AUTHORITIES DURING THE LAST FEW MONTHS. AS A RESULT, THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT HAS AGREED TO EXTEND THE PRESENT AGREEMENT FOR A FURTHER FOUR-YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 1950. TRAINING TO "WINGS" STANDARD WILL BE PROVIDED ANNUALLY TO THIRTY STUDENT PILOTS AND THREE STUDENT NAVIGATORS FROM NORWAY. A TOKEN PAYMENT OF \$5,000 PER STUDENT PILOT ENTRANT AND OF \$2,000 PER STUDENT NAVIGATOR ENTRANT WILL BE MADE BY NORWAY. CANADIAN COSTS WILL BE DEFRAYED UNDER CANADA'S MUTUAL AID PROGRAMME.
