

- Osaka will become available for service by Canadian carriers when the new Kansai Interational Airport opens as expected in 1993.
- In addition to JAL's services to Vancouver and Toronto from Tokyo, Japanese services may also operate from a second city in Japan and to a third city in Canada of Japan's choice.
- The agreement also provides greater flexibility for the extension of Japanese services beyond Vancouver to other countries.
