PRAYERS.

Mr. Martin (Essex East), seconded by Mr. McIlraith, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-88, An Act to amend the Expropriation Act, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

By unanimous consent, Mr. Fulton, seconded by Mr. Hees, moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole later this day to consider the following proposed resolution which has been recommended to the House by His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of Canada:

That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Judges Act to provide salary for an additional Judge of the Supreme Court of Judicature of Prince Edward Island.
