PRAYERS.

Mr. Lessard (Lac-Saint-Jean), from the Standing Committee on Agriculture, presented the Fourth Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Tuesday, April 14, 1970, your Committee has considered Bill C-196, An Act respecting grain, and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 2

Strike out line 30 on page 2 and substitute the following therefor: 'handling and storing grain received directly from'

Strike out line 39 on page 2 and substitute the following therefor: 'handling and storing grain as part of the operation'

Strike out line 20 on page 3 and substitute the following therefor: 'handling and storing grain received directly from'

Strike out line 29 on page 3 and substitute the following therefor: 'handling and storing grain as part of the opera-'

Strike out lines 14 to 18 inclusive on page 6 and substitute the following therefor:

'(28) "Minister" means the Minister of Agriculture;' Strike out in line 39 on page 8 the words 'in condition'.

Clause 6

Strike out lines 38 to 40 inclusive on page 10 and substitute the following therefor:

"(3) A commissioner ceases to hold office upon attaining the age of sixty-five years, except that where the Governor in Council is of opinion
