## GREETING:

## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS in and by subsection (1) of section 24 of the Maritime Transportation Unions Trustees Act, being chapter 17 of the statutes of 1963, it is provided that the said Act expires on the thirty-first day of December, 1966, unless before that date it is extended to a later date which may be fixed by proclamation of Our Governor in Council.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the date on which the said Act expires be extended to the thirty-first day of December, 1967.

Now KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, do

by this Our Proclamation declare and direct that the date on which the said Act expires be extended to the thirty-first day of December, 1967.

ALL OF WHICH Our Loving Subjects and all others whom these Presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our right Trusty and Well-beloved Counsellor, General Georges P. Vanier, a member of Our Most Honourable Privy Council, Companion of Our Distinguished Service Order upon whom We have conferred Our Military Cross and Our Canadian Forces' Decoration, Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Canada.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE, in Our City of Ottawa, this thirtieth day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and in the fifteenth year of Our Reign.
