There are 41 \$1 votes in these Supplementary Estimates. A listing of these votes, as well as additional explanations relating to four miscellaneous \$1 votes, have been provided to members of the committee.

Hon. H. A. Olson: Honourable senators, Bill C-119 has exactly the same subject matter as what we dealt with in Supplementary Estimate (C). The deputy house leader, Senator Lynch-Staunton, has just given us a little more explanation than was reported by me on behalf of the committee. I do not know if a different pattern could be followed with this bill, but as far as I am concerned it is ready for second reading now, because we have dealt with it both here and in the committee.

Motion agreed to and bill read second time.

## THIRD READING

The Hon. the Speaker: Honourable senators, when shall this bill be read the third time?

**Senator Lynch-Staunton:** With leave of the Senate and notwithstanding rule 59(1)(b), I move that the bill be read the third time now.

The Hon. the Speaker: Is leave granted, honourable senators?

Hon. Senators: Agreed.

Motion agreed to and bill read third time and passed.
