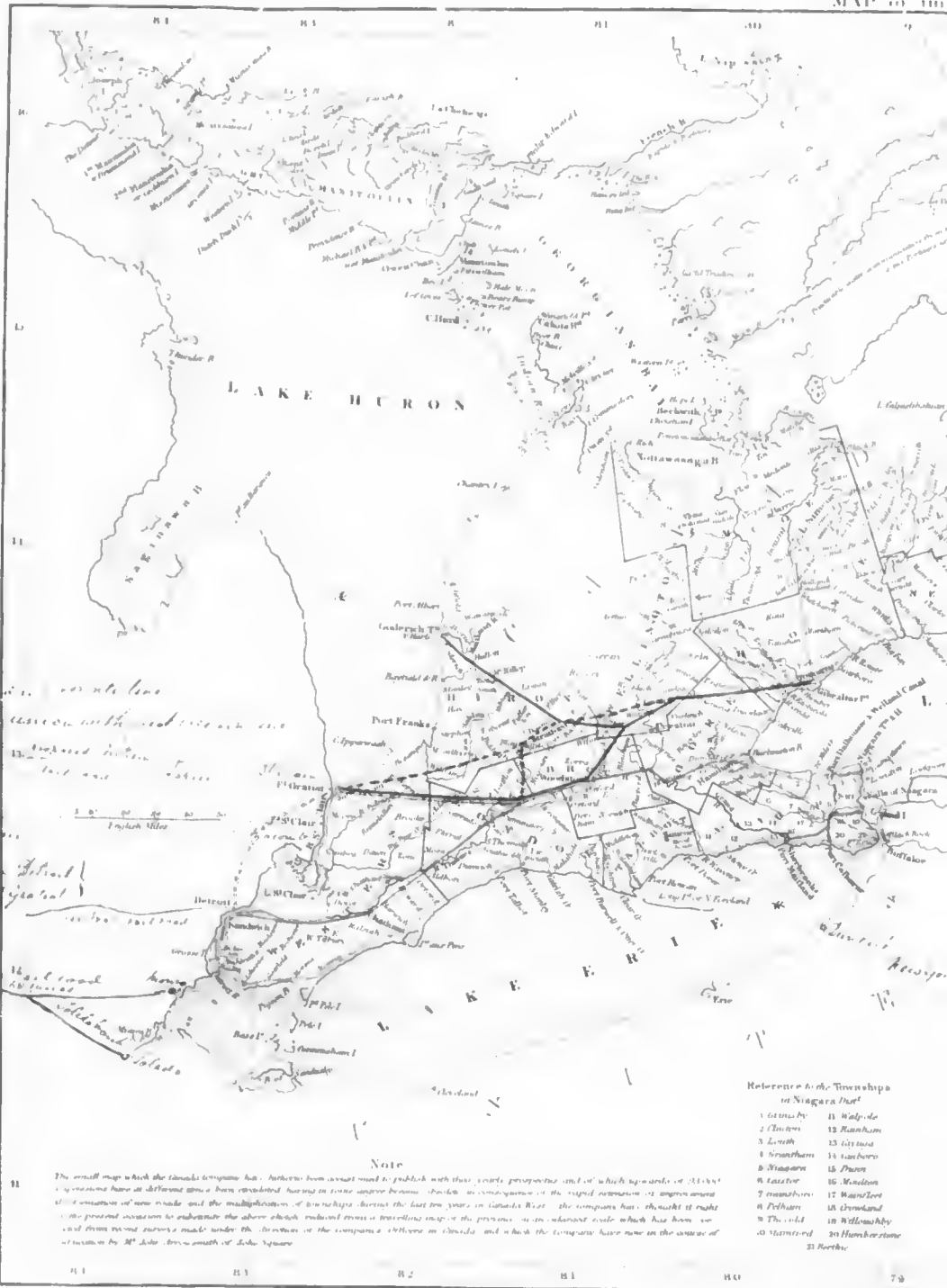

The small map which the Niagara Company has published, has been used to publish with their maps, prospectus and of which upwards of 10,000 copies have at different times been circulated, having in some degree become obsolete, in consequence of the rapid extension of the river, and the consequent extension of new roads and the multiplication of townships, during the last few years in Ontario. The company has, therefore, thought it right to present this map to substantiate the above claims, and to show the progress of the river, in its various course, which has been derived from recent surveys made under the direction of the company's officers, and which the company have now in the course of publication by H. J. Deane, south of Lake Square.
