ART. IX.—CHANGE OF CONSTITUTION,

This Constitution may be changed at any Annual Meeting of the Board of Managers by a two-thirds vote of each Branch delegation, notice of such amendment having been given to each Branch before its Annual Meeting; but Art. VIII. shall not be changed, except with the concurrence of the General Board of Missions of the Methodist Church.

By-Laws.

1. The Corresponding Secretary of each Branch shall be required to furnish in her report, in schedule form, to the Annual Meeting of the Board of Managers, the following items:

Also a list of Life-members and Annual Members, and the report of the Branch Treasurer.

2. Each Branch Treasurer shall furnish the Corresponding Secretary an annual report, in schedule form, of moneys received by her quarterly, and the sources of income.

3. The General Treasurer shall publish each quarter, in the

Outlook, the moneys received by her.

4. When delegates to the General Board are elected at the Branch Annual Meetings they shall meet at once, and select three of their number, who shall be members of the Nominating Committee, and who shall meet one hour previous to the opening session of the Board, to arrange for committees and their times and places of meeting.

5. Certificates of Membership may be granted to annual members of any Auxiliary who may be changing their place of residence, which shall constitute them members of the Auxiliary in the place to which they remove.
